**PARENTAL RELEASE OF  
STUDENT IMAGES AND SCHOOL WORK**

When Yukon students work on their lessons or take part in special events, there are often some great photo opportunities. Collecting and using images of students and their schoolwork can be a powerful tool for promoting student achievement, supporting the learning process, and showcasing the school and its programs.

Images and/or recordings of your child are considered their personal information. The Department of Education collects this information for the purpose of communications with the public and school community, under the authority of the *Education Act* and the *Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act* s.15(c)(i). The Department of Education would like your permission to use images and/or recordings of your child and their schoolwork. This may include photographs, video recordings and audio recordings.

Places where images or recordings of students and their work may be seen or heard by the public include:

- School or Government of Yukon websites and social media accounts (including but not limited to Facebook, Instagram, YouTube).
- Yukon government or school communications such as newsletters, yearbooks, brochures, reports, and advertising.
- External media communications such as newspapers, websites, radio and television.

Note that these images or recordings may be used beyond the current school year unless this permission is revoked. Consent can be revoked by contacting the school.

The Department of Education may also share these images or recordings with its education partners, including (but not limited to) other Yukon government departments, the Yukon First Nation School Board, and the Yukon Francophone School Board/Commission scolaire francophone du Yukon.

Please be aware that external media organizations (CBC, Yukon News, etc.) may attend public events such as concerts, plays, graduation ceremonies and inter-school sport competitions. School staff are not able to control media access to these types of events.
